2009 BCSA FINE ARTS COMPETITION

Three hundred sixty nine students from ten schools congregated for the 28th annual BCSA Fine Arts Competition held on March 12 & 13 at Zanesville Christian School. Schools involved this year were Bethel Baptist School, Fayette Christian School, Heritage Christian School, Licking County Christian Academy, Lima Christian Academy, Mentor Christian School, Northside Christian School, Temple Christian Academy, Wayside Christian School, and Zanesville Christian School. Collectively, the students competed in around 1,480 events including testing, projects and scheduled events. The buildings were a beehive of activity. Congratulations go to Licking County Christian Academy which won the highest point trophy and to Lima Christian Academy which won the highest average trophy. Congratulations also go to Edith Howell and Michael Riggs both of Zanesville Christian who won the outstanding competitor awards.

Highlights of this year's competition were as follows: 1) Being able to leave all the projects set up for both days; 2) The harp solo presented by Sarah Kalmbach of Heritage Christian School; 3) The duet acting presented by Elizabeth Zimmerman & Hans Wagner of Northside Christian School; 4) The instrumental string solo presented by Tyler Hacker of Northside Christian School ; 5) The vocal quartet presented by Sarai Dahlhausen, Jonathan McLean, Erika Noble, & Chris Stathopoulos of Mentor Christian School; 6) The dramatic interpretation presented by Jacqueline Smith of Licking County Christian Academy; and 7) The new awards given to the winners of each division.

A great big thank you goes to each judge who made the competition a huge success. Thank you also go to the ZCS staff, students, and volunteers for their excellent work in hosting another great competition. They are very much appreciated.
